Here is the whole rule...

"Unless otherwise specified for special events, jackets and closed toed, closed heel shoes for men and similarly suitable attire for women are required while in the Dining Room on Saturday evenings. Casual attire is permitted at all other times and places. Casual attire means collared shirts, neat slacks, dress shorts for gentlemen and similarly suitable attire for women. Cut-offs, midriff tanks, men's sleeveless tee shirts, bare feet and all articles of blue denim are prohibited in all areas at all times. After 6 pm, all men's shirts must be tucked in. Bathing suits, when properly covered, and presentable tee shirts free of offensive slogans or words are permitted in outdoor areas until 6 pm. Tennis whites and athletic attire are prohibited in the Dining Room and are permitted on the Orlop Deck until 10 pm and elsewhere only until 6 pm. Everyone is required to remove their hats when indoors. Children over 10 are expected to adhere to the dress code."
